## THE GOLDEN DOMES OF THE ZAMOSKVORETCHIE

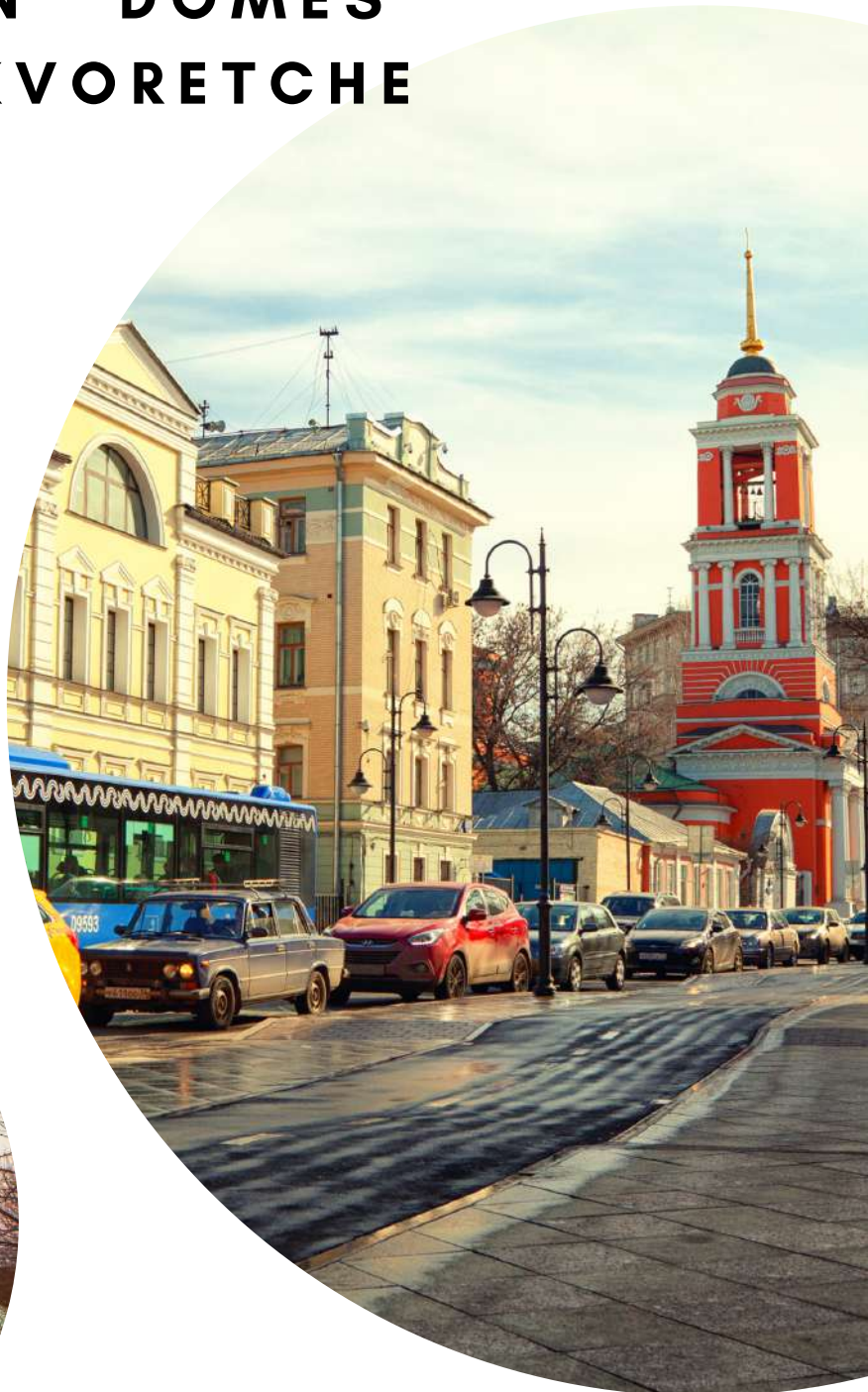

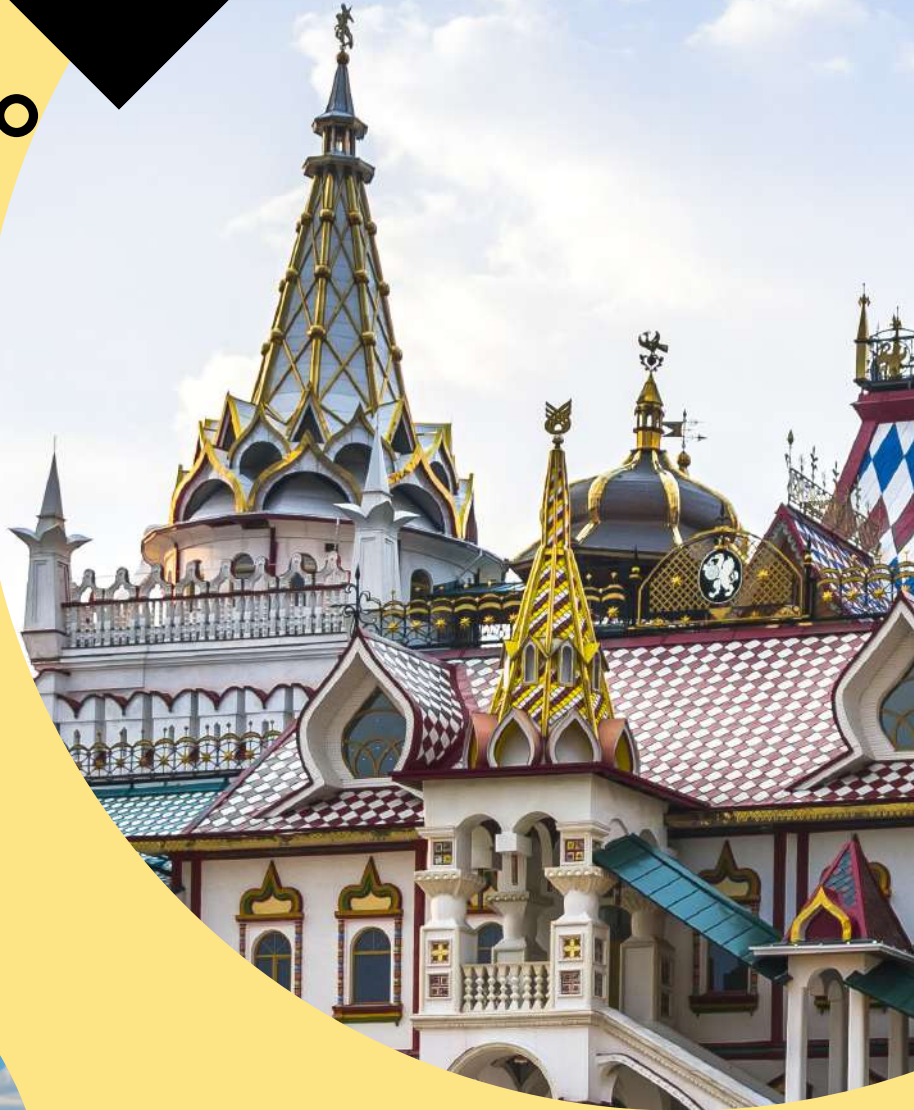

## KOLOMENSKOYE ESTATE

The ancient domain of the Moscow Princes, and then the Czars of Russia from the 14th century, Kolomenskoye Park is a greenspace where the Museum and the Church of the Ascension, the first church made of stones in an octagonal shape in Russia and classified as UNESCO World Heritage Site, are nested. This is a relaxing and instructive excursion in the heart of Russian nature.

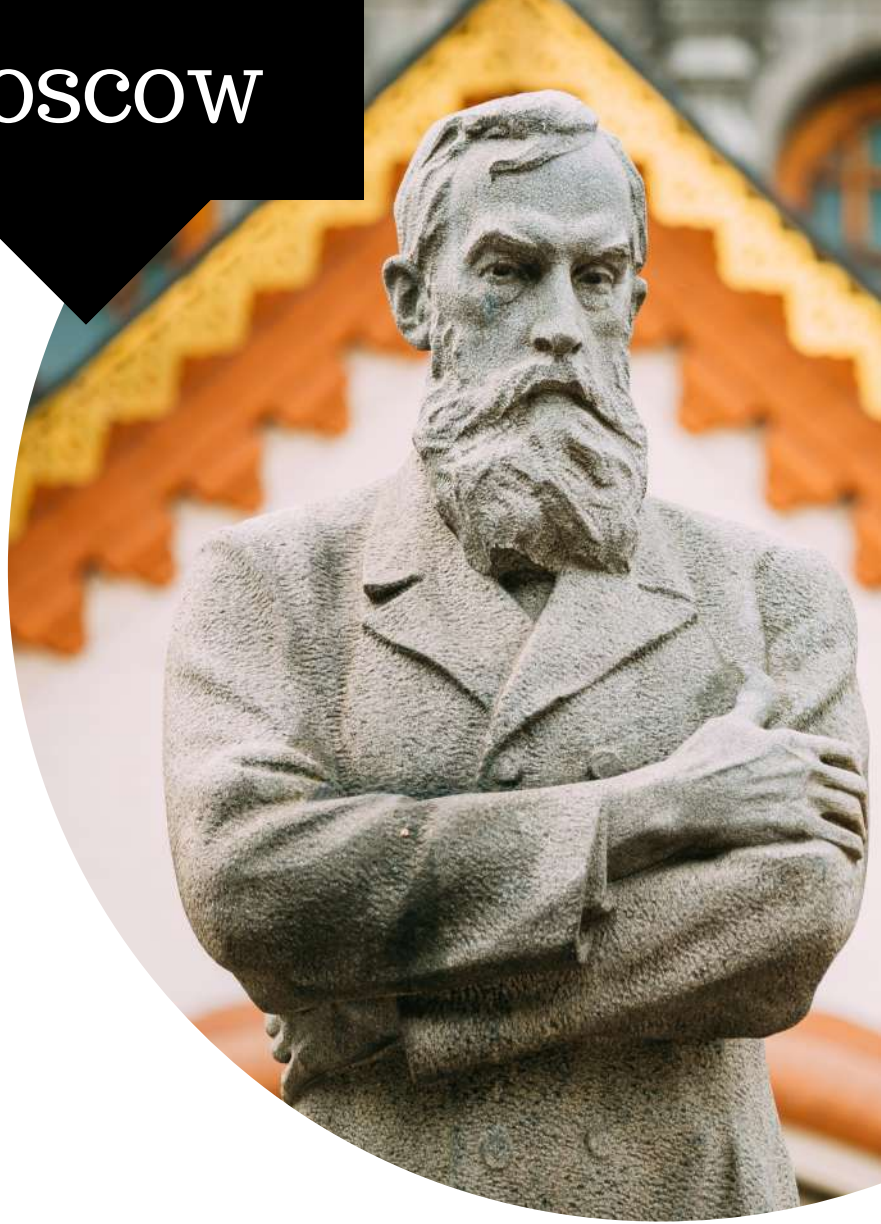

## TRETYAKOV GALLERY

An essential museum to visit while in Moscow, the Tretyakov Gallery possesses one of the largest collections of icons and Russian paintings from the 12th to the 20th century. While exploring the museum with your guide, you will discover the richness of Russian culture throughout the centuries.

## THE IMPRESSIONISTS AT THE PUSHKIN MUSEUM

A museum of antique and contemporary collections, the Pushkin Museum is a museum rich in Russian, European, and ancient paintings and and works of art. The Pushkin Museum has preserved its original purposes of instruction and education.

## THE MUSEUM OF COSMONAUTICS

A must-see for those who want to know everything about space adventure, the Museum of Cosmonautics traces the history of astronautics from the 1920's to the present day. Located at the entrance of the VDNKh Exhibition Park, it is impressive for its architecture and especially for the diversity and richness of its collections.

## BUNKER 42 AT THE TAGANKA METRO

Dive more than 60m underground to the most secret and secure bunker of the USSR. A former military communication post, the Taganka Bunker is a museum off the beaten track, a veritable labyrinth of the atomic era where the atmosphere of the Cold War continues to exist.

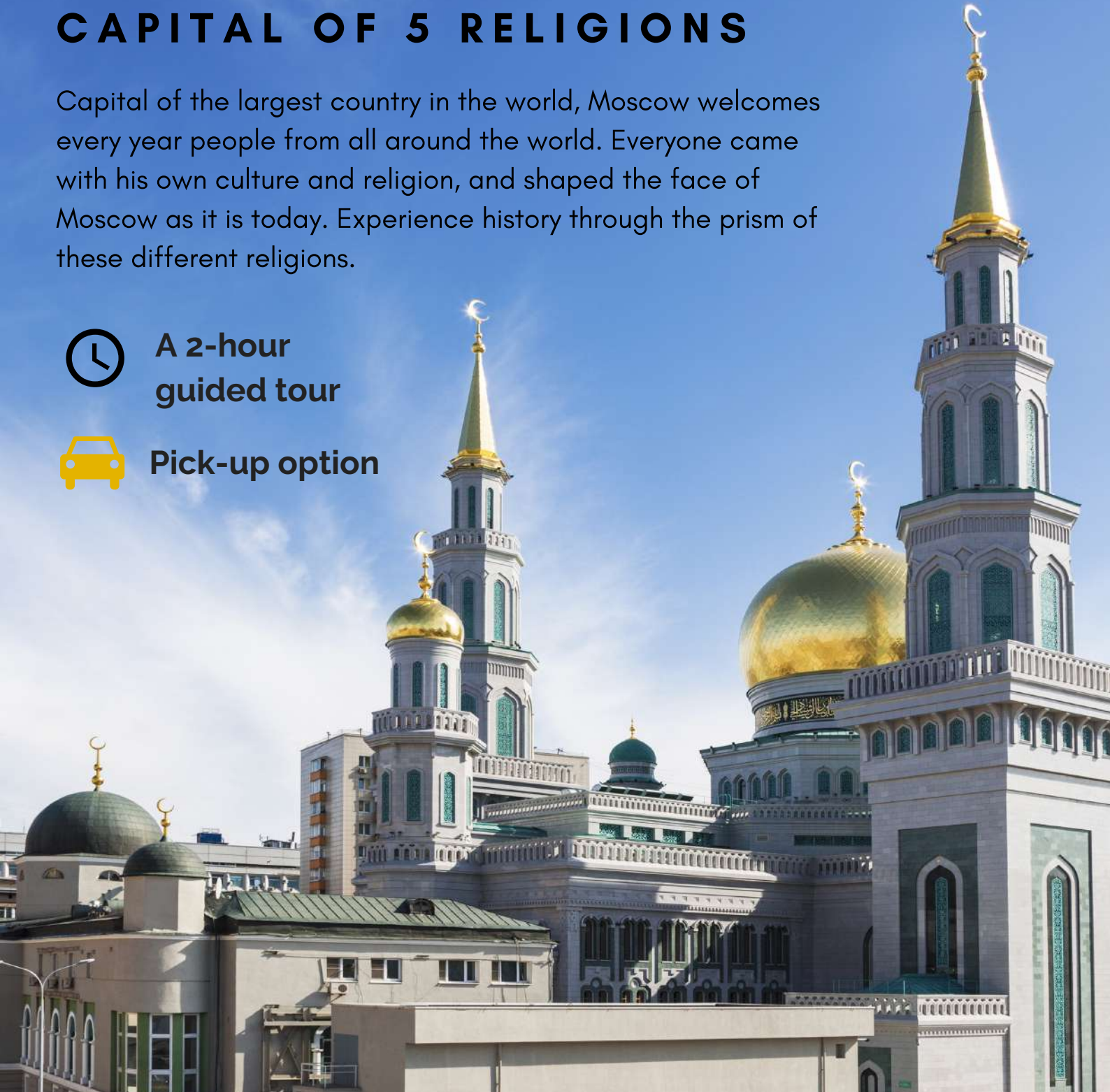

## TSARSKOYE SELO

The summer residence of the Russian Czars, Tsarskoye Selo is a “Imperial village” that contains the Catherine Palace and the Alexander Palace (currently in restoration). This is an essential visit as a part of a tour of St. Petersburg for the sumptuous decorations, the pastel-colored facades, and especially the magnificent gardens of the favorite residence of Nicholas II.

## THE HERMITAGE

Whether for the Palaces themselves, or for the collections they house, the Hermitage is the must-see museum during any stay in St. Petersburg. From the antiquities to the Impressionists to the great European schools of art, the largest museum in the world will only surprise and delight you.

**You will see: the Small Hermitage, the Old Hermitage, the New Hermitage, the Winter Palace and the General Staff Building. The State Halls and St. George's Hall, the gallery of portraits of the Romanovs, the famous "Peacock Clock", the Raphael Loggias and the glass collection of the Museum of Porcelain, the collections of European art from the 13th century, including paintings from Raphael, Rubens, and Rembrandt, the collection of French art from the 14th to the 20th century**





## PETERHOF PALACE

The “Russian Versailles” and the symbol of Russia’s elevation to a position of power within Europe, the Peterhof Palace is, without a doubt, one of the most sumptuous palaces within Russia. With your guide, discover the magnificence of the Imperial palace and its Gardens, in which the fountains are some of the greatest curiosities.

## CATHEDRAL OF THE SAVIOUR ON SPILLED BLOOD

One of the most well-known and picturesque places in St. Petersburg, the Cathedral of the Saviour on Spilled Blood commemorates the location of the assassination of Czar Alexander II. Built in the neo-Russian style and comprised of 7500m<sup>2</sup> of mosaics, a visit to the cathedral is an essential tour for any stay in St. Petersburg.

## PETER AND PAUL FORTRESS

A very important military and religious site, the Saints Peter and Paul Fortress is one of the most well-known symbols of St. Petersburg. Its cathedral, whose spire is a St. Petersburg landmark, contains the sepulchres of the Romanov Czars and their families. The Fortress is an essential visit for anyone who wishes to know St. Petersburg and Russia.
